SAGA LiDAR/Aerial Project Update:

Hoffman stated that the new aerials looked good. The eastern side of the county was flown when it was still quite cold and there were some areas that show ice and snow on the ground, but very little.

Grose mentioned that we were waiting to hear on the grant application. We applied to the USGS along with 15 other counties.

FEMA would like to have our new data for flood mapping. FEMA is no longer producing hard copies of their maps, only digital versions.

Hoffman reported that Dow would be receiving our data later that week.
